

## Transitioning ICHA Clients into Permanent Primary Care Services in the Community

### Consider transitioning clients when they meet ONE or more of the following:

- Client is able and willing to transition into the community for care. Example: Able to attend appointments
- Client has found housing
- Client no longer requires low barrier services

### Resources and Supports

- Contact ICHA Community Nurse for a list of primary care services available and appropriate for client.
- Contact ICHA Community Nurse for clients that may require additional support transitioning into the community.

### Follow-up Supports

- Please notify ICHA community nurse for *ANY* of your clients that have been transitioned, *in order to track progress*.
- The community nurse will follow-up with patient to provide any necessary supports and ensure that the transition was successful for the client.
